RESCUE KIT 1P: 0103-04-012P

The Rescue Communication Kit 1P is configured for a team of five First Responders consisting of two primary rescuers, two standby rescuers and a Hole watch / Team leader, for entries of 100' (maximum distance 1500'). The System can be configured for up to fourteen people using available modules and accessories.



USAR TASKFORCE KIT: 0103-04-055

A Hardline two-way voice communication system designed to meet multiple technical rescue needs. These include, Confined Space, High Angle, Structural Collapse, Victim Location, Shoring, Tunneling and Trench Rescue. The Kit can be configured according to the type of rescue involved, so whether it's a two-in-two-out or a five-person Search & Rescue team the USAR Task Force Kit has you covered. It's the all-in-one technical rescue communication system!



VICTIM LOCATOR KIT: 0103-10-031

Includes the all-new CON-SPACE Rescue Probe, a two-way voice communication device for locating and communicating with victims of a structural collapse. Multiple Kits can be deployed simultaneously on the same site without interfering with each other. Each system can be used by single or multiple rescuers during searches.



DECONTAMINATION KIT: 0103-04-051

The CON-SPACE Decon Kit 1 is configured to provide communication for a team of five (Administrator [takes notes]; Washer/Wetter; Stripper; Flusher; Clothier). It uses the environmentally sealed CSI-2100 Command Module designed to work in hazardous environments and survive the roughest of handling. Ideal for Mass Hospital Decontamination.



BOMB DISPOSAL KIT: 0103-10-030

The Bomb Disposal Kit is a Hardline Communication System designed to provide private, communication for a team of three Bomb Specialists wearing Face Shields and Full Body Armor for protection. The system is NON-RF emitting and conforms to MIL-STD 461.



POWER TALK BOX SYSTEM: 1120-01-012

The Power Talk Box System provides a means of simple, untethered, two-way voice communication. With a unit at each end the system is ideal for High Angle or Trench rescues where breathing apparatus and/or face-masks are not necessary. Simply speak and be heard from within a 30 ft. radius of each box.



SR65i RADIO ACCESSORY: 1918-01-000

The SR65i makes the use of handheld radios easy for First Responders. When moving from a high-to-low noise area users need not change accessories even while wearing any type of facemask with breathing apparatus, encapsulated suits, or respirators. The revolutionary Throat Mic is sensitive allowing users to talk normally or even whisper and still be heard.
